
What is a mindset?

New England Compounding Chemist (NECC)





Fungal meningitis outbreak in 2012 linked to steroid injections resulted in 753 cases across 20 states with 64 people dead.

Gauging your cleaners' cleanroom mindset



- ✓ What equipment do they use?
- ✓ Are they trained in its correct usage?
- ✓ Who keeps up with equipment innovations?
- ✓ If it is not a consumable, where is the item stored?
- ✓ How are items introduced into your cleanroom?
- ✓ Are the chemicals being used actually the ones specified in your SOP?
- √ Whose job description includes checking expiry dates?
- ✓ Do your cleaners provide exception reports?

Gauging your cleaners' cleanroom mindset



- ✓ How are vacations and sick leave handled?
- ✓ What happens when cleanroom cleaners turn up sick for work?
- ✓ Is there a team with back-ups ready to come in on short notice?
- √ How often is training held?
- ✓ How often is the cleaning SOP reviewed?
- ✓ Do you use your training records to identify gaps in knowledge?
- ✓ Do you also apply a cleanroom mindset to your documentation and reporting?
